TISSUES

Simple Columnar Epithelium:

- Tall, pillar like cells with oval nucleus which lies close to the base of cell.
- In Respiratory tract the columnar epithelium, cover with cilia.

Location: Stomach lining, Repository tract, Gastric glands, intestinal glands, pancreatic tubules.

Stratified Columnar Epithelium:

- **Stratified Columnar Epithelium:**

Columnar cells over layers of cuboidal cells.

Location: Covers epiglottis, lining of mammary gland ducts and parts of Urethra.
